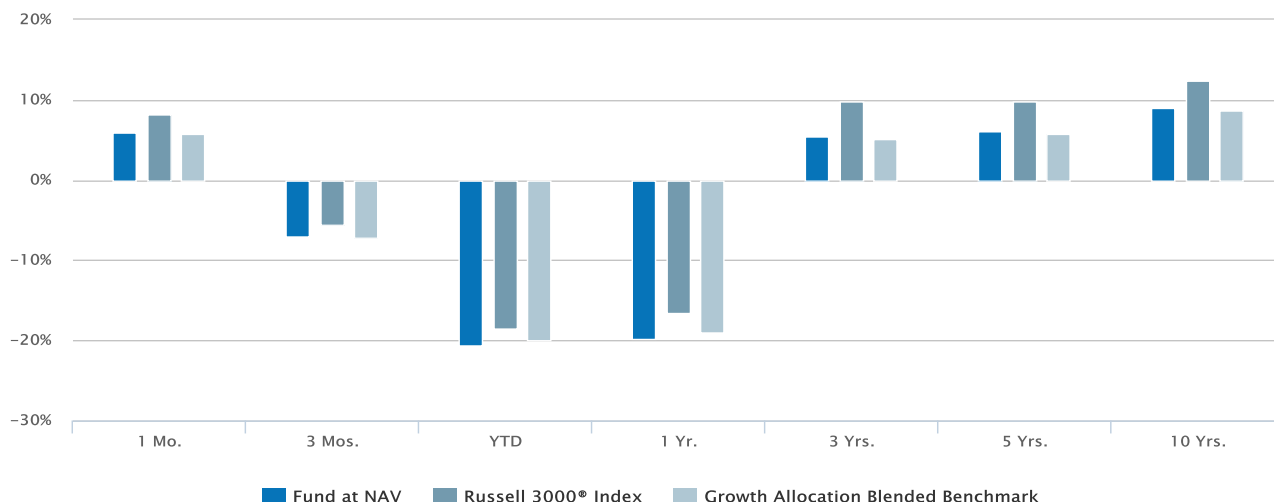

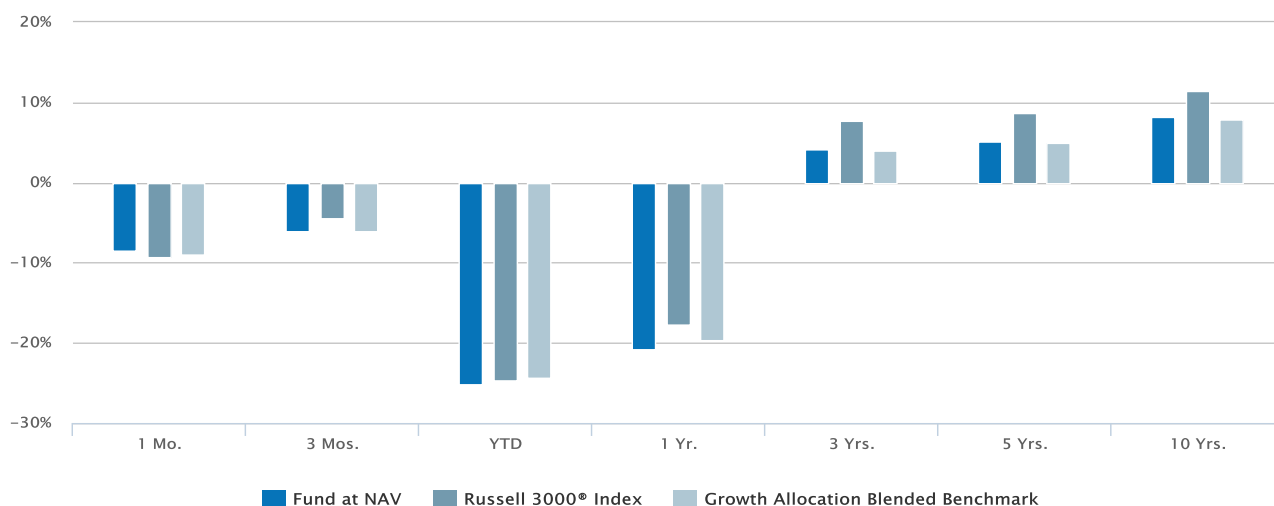

## RISK CONSIDERATIONS

The Fund invests in other underlying funds in a fund-of-funds structure. 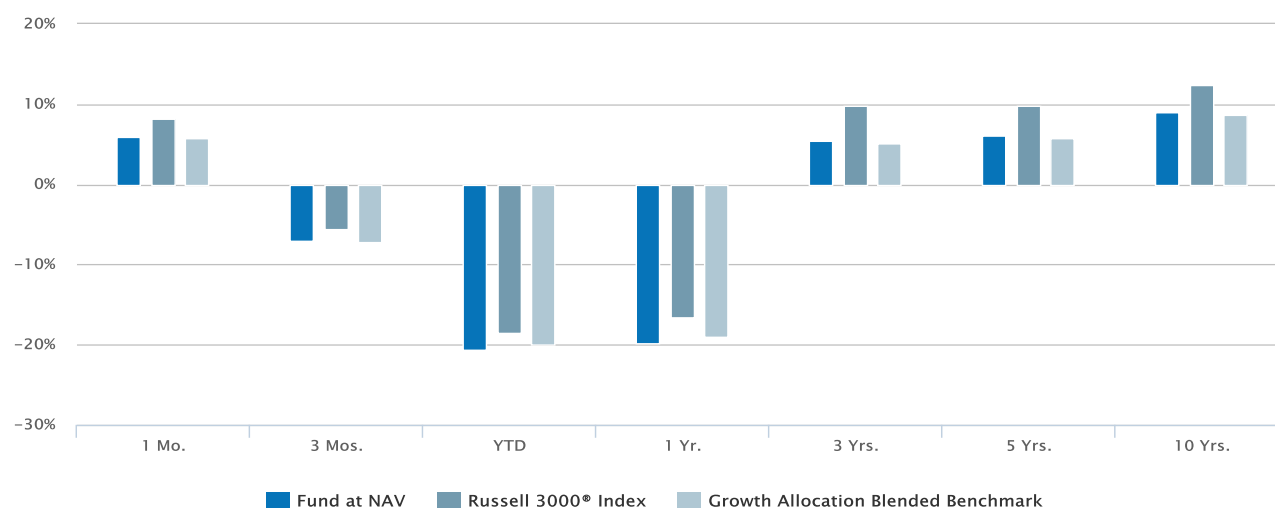

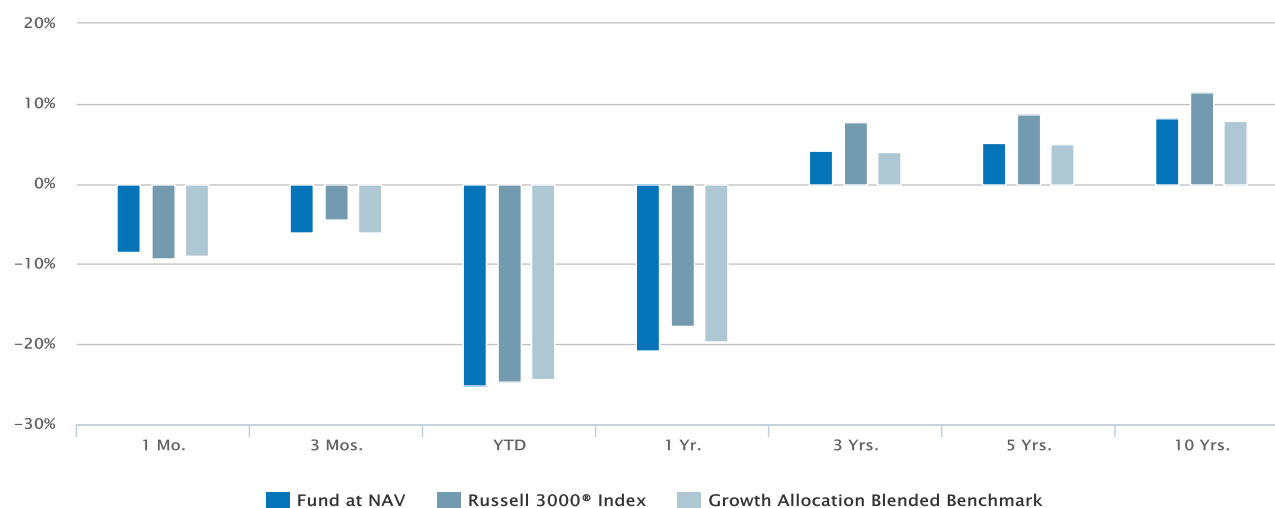

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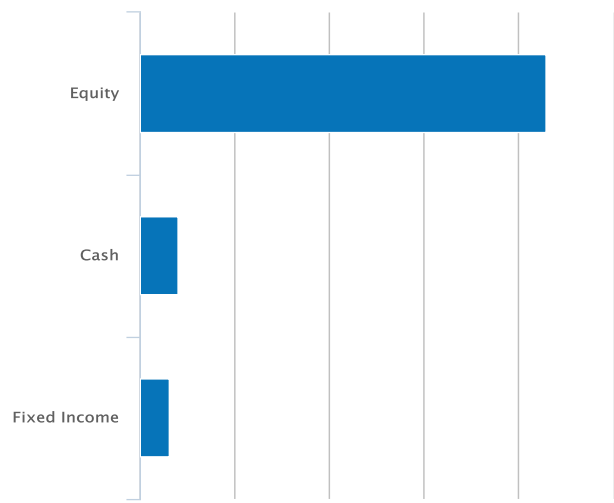
