The exam focuses on the impact of sustainability factors on ?nancial performance, the legal context of material sustainability information, as well as the development of a common language to describe the materiality of sustainability information to ?nance, legal and accounting professionals.

The FSA program is designed to help investors understand the link between material sustainability information and a company's ?nancial performance and how to integrate ESG factors into investment decisions.
